In addition, uninsured patients can come to NCHS and pay a flat fee which includes their medical visit, plus any labs, x-rays or procedures they would need – included in one low price, depending on income and family size.

“This building not only creates a brand new health center for our community, but will enable us to continue to deliver quality care to our current and future patients” says Cota, “helping us fulfill our mission, which is to improve the health status of our diverse communities.”
