NCHS has recently remodeled their Mission Mesa Campus to include the Mission Mesa Women's Health Center, Mission Mesa Pediatrics Health Center, and NCHS WIC. The new Mission Mesa Women's Health Center has been tailored to better serve the community of Oceanside with improved efficiency and enhanced healthcare delivery. Today, the newly remodeled facility has increased capacity by 66% and will help accommodate the expected population growth in the upcoming years.
